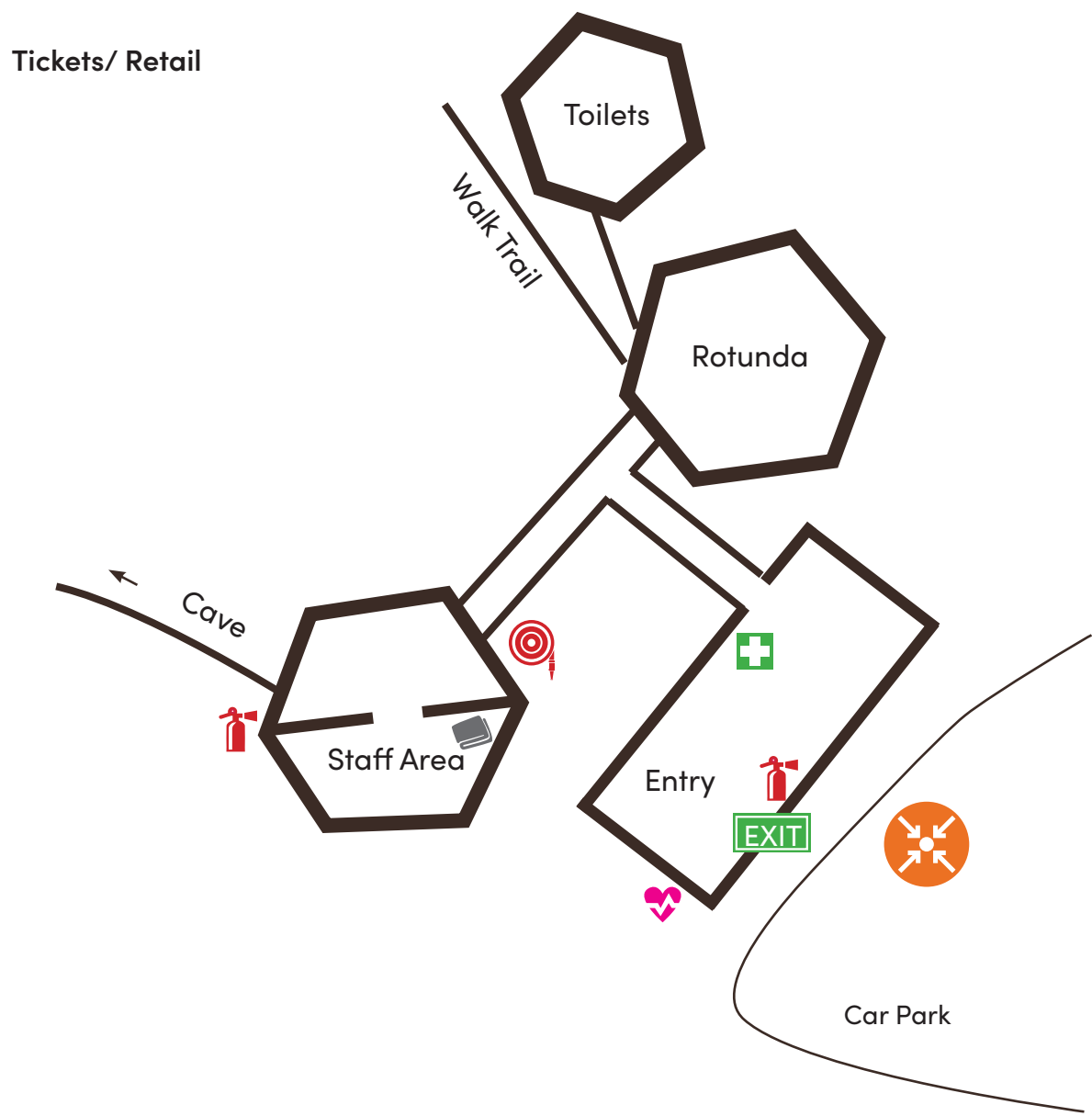










# Mammoth Cave
